



ERNIE GARE ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP SOCIETY FOR HIGH SCHOOL APPLICANTS

Ernie Gare believed young people were our most important resource and he dedicated his life to teaching them. In 1964, he started the first University Athletic Scholarship in Canada for hockey and skiing. For ten years, the scholarship programmes flourished under his guidance, graduating 65 athletes. Then, in 1979, Ernie Gare was diagnosed with Lou Gehrig's Disease (A.L.S.) and died February 22, 1981, aged 52. In 1982, following his death, a group of prominent citizens reinstated the Ernie Gare Scholarship Society to continue Ernie's legacy of helping young athletes to continue their education. It is now the longest-running scholarship program in Canada.

The Ernie Gare Athletic Scholarship Society will award scholarships to deserving athletes who meet all criteria. These scholarships are awarded to assist local graduating students (Dogwood Certificate minimum) of LV Rogers High School, Mt. Sentinel Secondary School, J.V. Humphries High School, and Salmo Secondary School in meeting the cost of their educational endeavors at the post secondary level (university, college, vocational school). We value equity, diversity and inclusion and encourage all athletes to apply.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Deadline for application is April 30.
2. Only completed online applications will be reviewed.
3. The applicant must be enrolled in a post-secondary institution within fifteen months of high school graduation.

CRITERIA

1. Level of participation

Candidates must have participated in at least one sport during their senior years (Grade 11 and 12). This may be the same sport in both years or two different sports over the course of Grade 11 and 12. (i.e. soccer in Grade 11/12, hockey in Grade 11 and skiing in Grade 12).

2. Education

Candidate requires a minimum C+ average in academic course work in both Grade 11 and 12 without a failing grade in any academic course. Applicants must be enrolling in a Canadian Post-Secondary Institution.

4. Citizenship

Must be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident. Visa students are not eligible.

5. Eligible Sports

Those sports recognized in the Olympic Games, Pan American Games, Canada Games or Commonwealth Games.

6. Full Scholarships

Candidates who have already qualified for a full scholarship (2-4 years of funded tuition, either partly or in full) are not eligible for this high school scholarship.
