APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND TERMS OF REFERENCE

L.V. ROGERS SCHOOL, NELSON, B.C.

The Nelson Waldorf School is offering a Scholarship to a Waldorf School Alumni graduating from L.V. Rogers School, Nelson, British Columbia.

A Committee will be appointed by the Nelson Waldorf School Faculty to review applications and award the Scholarship.

The following criteria are required in consideration of Scholarship applicants:

1. Applications must be received by the Nelson Waldorf School not later than April 15
2. One Scholarship or award of \$500 will be given to the successful applicant.
3. The Scholarship or Award will be paid at the graduation ceremony of the L.V. Rogers School
4. Applicant must meet the following criteria:
 - Be registered at L.V. Rogers School
 - Complete Grade 12 curriculum at L.V. Rogers School
 - Have attended Nelson Waldorf School
 - Submit a response to questions (see attached) and submit a 300-400 word essay (see attached criteria), or if requested meet with the Scholarship Committee
 - Give permission for the essay to be referenced "Alumni Perspective" for NWS Website
 - Be willing to speak to parents as Alumni of NWS, if requested.
5. All applicants will be notified of the results of this competition by May 30
