
Bragagnolo Bursary

The Bragagnolo Bursary was established by the Blewett School community in 1980 as a tribute to Mr. Bragagnolo. He was the principal at Blewett Elementary from 1966 to 1980. The bursary is awarded annually to a deserving student who has enrolled in a post-secondary institution.

Criteria

The following guidelines will be followed in the selection process:

- *A graduating student from LV Rogers or Mt. Sentinel who has attended Blewett Elementary for a minimum of 1 school year (excluding Kindergarten/Grade one).*
- *The successful candidate must be continuing his/her education (colleges and technical schools are included).*
- *Candidates must apply for the bursary. - A need for financial assistance will be considered.*

Applicants must be Canadian citizens, or permanent residents (landed immigrants) residing in SD8 Kootenay Lake, and must fulfill the BC Graduation requirements by August 31st of the student's graduating year.
