

9.4 Scholarships

Policy

The purpose of this policy is to support a student to participate in post-secondary education.

- 1. One Scholarship shall be awarded per year.
- 2. Current Board or staff members and their families are ineligible to apply.
- 3. The scholarship recipient shall be selected from candidates that demonstrate the following attributes:
 - a. A candidate who has shown worthwhile contributions to a provincial or national association in sport as an athlete, and/or official, or club/district administrator.
 - b. The candidate must have demonstrated good citizenship, character and leadership.
 - c. Students proceeding from Grade 12 to university or other secondary institution approved by the NRSC Scholarship selection committee.
- 4. The Scholarship Selection Committee shall not enter into correspondence with the candidate, their family or agent.
- 5. The decision of the committee is final.

Procedures

- 1. Candidates must complete the NRSC Scholarship application form in its entirety to be considered. All parts must be complete.
- 2. Candidates submit the application to their high school within the relevant school policies and deadlines, or if Homeschooled, submit directly to the NRSC. (Address above.)
- 3. School staff shall forward all application from their school and submit these to the NRSC by April
- 4. It is the candidate's responsibility to ensure that the application is complete and that all required information and documentation is enclosed with the application.
- 5. NRSC committee shall accept all submission from each local high school in the region and select one recipitent per year from either: LVR, Mount Sentinel, Salmo Secondary, JV Humphries (or a Homeschooled student).
- 6. The NRSC selection committee shall select one recipient from the submissions.
- 7. The NRSC committee decision and announcement shall be made to the recipient school counsellor and School District 8 by May 30.
- 8. The Scholarship shall be awarded at the graduation ceremony, or in the case of a Homeschooled student, mailed directly to the students home upon proof of post-secondary attendance (see below).

9. Condition:

a. The funds shall be distributed by the Osprey Foundation to the School District #8 who will in turn issue to the student upon proof that he/she is attending a post-secondary institution as approved by the selection committee.
