APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Nelson Waldorf School is offering a Scholarship to two Waldorf School Alums graduating from their high school in 2024. A Scholarship of \$500 each will be given to two successful applicants.

Applicant must meet the following criteria:

- *Be registered at a high school and Complete Grade 12 curriculum*
- *Have attended Nelson Waldorf School*
- *Submit a response to questions (see attached) and submit a 300-400 word essay (see attached criteria)*
- *Meet with the Scholarship Committee, if requested*
- *Give permission for the essay to be referenced "Alum Perspective" for NWS Website*
- *Be willing to speak to parents as an Alum of NWS, if requested*

*Applications must be received by the Nelson Waldorf School not later than **May 1st, 2024.***

A Committee will be appointed by the Nelson Waldorf School Faculty to review applications and award the Scholarships. The Scholarship will be awarded at the graduation ceremony/ paid directly to the candidate.

All applicants will be notified of the results of this competition by May 30th, 2024.
