Applications must be received by the Nelson Waldorf School not later than May 1st, 2024.

A Committee will be appointed by the Nelson Waldorf School Faculty to review applications and award the Scholarships. The Scholarship will be awarded at the graduation ceremony/paid directly to the candidate.
