Greg Stacey dedicated his life to helping people and communities as a lawyer, a volunteer, and friend. Coming from a humble background, he became a mentor, advocate, critic, historian, and a champion for those less privileged in terms of education, job opportunities, family support, or social stability.

The Greg Stacey Memorial bursary aims to assist students who could benefit from someone believing in their potential. Apart from the \$1000 award, the family also offers the chance to discuss the recipients' goals and aspirations. They may choose to accept or decline the option of additional support, including introductions that could help them pursue their goals.

Students from any field of study are welcome to apply, and while academic achievement is valued, it's not the primary criteria for receiving the award. The focus is on qualities like passion and vision.

Candidates are asked to write a letter that addresses the following questions:

- 1. What career to you aspire to, and how does this goal bring fulfillment to you?
- 2. Once you complete your studies, what do you aim to do, and why?
- 3. How do you perceive the importance of community service?
- 4. Besides financial assistance, what non-financial support would aid you in achieving your goals?

This bursary is supported by the Rotary Club of Nelson. Rotary is part of a worldwide organization whose members believe that they should serve their communities and promote international understanding. One local Rotary project is to provide scholarships to high school students. The Circle Foundation was established to serve Nelson and Area and its scope includes awarding of scholarships. Applications are due by May 1st, 2024. All submissions will be reviewed by the family.
