- SD8 Administrative Procedure 1403: Graduation Celebrations
- School roles in chronological order -
 - Graduation programming with individual students & families to meet requirements for graduation & post-secondary
 - Diploma Verification Reports
 - Show student's current standing in relation to graduation program
 - Updated every time a course is added/removed and grade is entered
 - Can get these from counsellors, principal/vice-principal, Secretary Julia
 - Post-Secondary Planning
 - See specific post-secondary institutions and programs for admissions requirements, sometimes requires contacting the post-secondary institution
 - Ongoing sharing of graduation-related information through grad google classroom & CLC classes
 - All students should have received an invitation to the grad google classroom
 - Will follow up on question about parents being invited to into grad google classroom
 - Capstone Project framework & presentations through CLC classes
 - In timetable CLC courses will have capstones completed on class schedule
 - Outside timetable CLC courses will complete capstones in May (dates TBD)
 - Graduation Literacy & Numeracy Assessments scheduling & tracking
 - Numeracy 10, Literacy 10, and Literacy 12 need to be written to graduate
 - Scores show up on transcript and on diploma verification reports
 - Post-secondary schools determine how the each used this scores
 - Can re-write up to three times to improve score
 - SD8 district graduation review meetings with school-based & district-Based teams
 - Meeting with school and district based teams to go through entire LVR & REACH graduation list to determine who is on track and who is at-risk
 - Meet 2-3 times per year with follow up work with students at-risk of not graduating
 - First review for LVR & REACH is October 30
 - Communication with Grad Parent Committee Executive
 - Parent Committee Executive is approximately 4-8 lead parents and is formed by letting Dan Rude know of your interest. Within the next couple weeks, Dan Rude will connect the interested parents with each other and last year's Parent Committee Executive to plan out who will take on which roles.
 - Support & oversee potential grad yearbook student team
 - Update Thanks to Elliot Wilson-Birks for committing to take the lead on the student yearbook this year. Elliot will need others to help out with the many roles for this.
 - Organizing grad photos dates

 - NDCC cost from last year = \$3583.47, paid through parent fundraising
- Grad Assemblies through the school year
 - Last year we had two in-person assemblies later in the year for various aspects of graduation planning

 - Will be updated regularly through the school year and the link will be included in the LVR weekly updates
