- Programs are just getting started in this area but services exist all over BC.
- Looking for input from parents and students at this time distribution of materials to share with kids and parents.
- 24-hour confidential access for youth
- Paid for by Kootenay Boundary Interior Health
- Kaien, Nicole and Michelle are based in Nelson and are helping to build the programs and find additional funding to support them.

Vice Principal's Report: Roman Wylie

- Hiring is complete arts is taking off.
- Terry fox run getting organized.
- Photo retakes on October 20.
- Grad parent meeting starting soon. Grad this year is scheduled for June 12, 2026.
- 2 PAC grant requests Dance trip to Vancouver and math contests for grades 10-12.
- Trustees have been selected and work has started for this group. Student leadership conference is upcoming.
- Anti-racism discussions happening with Intercultural Kootenays a few students and some teachers will attend an event in Salmo.
- Health Hub just started so LVR has a doctor on site and it operates like a real clinic.
- 4 people on staff are being trained on suicide prevention: training sessions could be offered soon. Also, Naloxone training for the new nasal spray option.

- Provincial assessment on Lit. 10 & 12 upcoming.
