

## **Rosanne Wallace Memorial Hockey Scholarship**

**Value:** \$1,000

### **About the scholarship**

This scholarship is awarded in the memory of the late Rosanne (Rose) Wallace of Trail, B.C., who was an integral part of female hockey development and coaching in the West Kootenays. Rose was a dedicated volunteer who was always willing to share her knowledge and passion for hockey. She played a significant role in coaching the Wildcats and established “Between the Pipes Goalie Academy” in Trail, B.C. helping aspiring goalies develop their skills and confidence. As a player, Rose played for the West Kootenay Wildcats female hockey team from 2004-2009. In 2007, Rose led the AAA West Kootenay Wildcats to win the Female Midget Provincial Championship. The Wildcats, with Rose between the pipes, went on to earn bronze in 2008 and silver in 2009 at the Female Midget Provincial Championship. Rose also played in the BC Winter games, leading Team Kootenay to Bronze in 2008. One of Rose’s most significant accomplishments during her youth hockey career was playing in net for Team B.C. at the U18 National Female Hockey Championship in Kitchener, Ontario in 2007. Up until her passing, Rose was a dedicated member of the Moguls, a men’s recreational hockey team based out of Rossland, B.C.

The scholarship will be awarded to a female hockey player that exhibits a passion for the game of hockey on and off the ice and intends to pursue post-secondary education.

### **Eligibility**

Applicants must be:

1. a female hockey player who resides in the Kootenay region of British Columbia or is a current/former member of the West Kootenay Wildcats,
  - a. Preference will be given to goaltenders.
2. a Canadian Citizen in their graduating year of high school, and
3. continuing their education at a post-secondary level (university, college or vocational school) within 15 months of high school graduation.

### **Applications must be accompanied by the following:**

A letter of reference from the applicant’s coach

A letter of reference from the applicant’s highschool principal or teacher

A copy of the applicants highschool transcript

**The deadline to apply is June 1, 2026.**
