AMOUNT: \$500 (3 awards)

CRITERIA

The Spearhead Bursary recognizes a graduating student who demonstrates a commitment to skilled trades and manufacturing careers, particularly in design, fabrication, or construction.

Eligible applicants must:

- Be a graduating Grade 12 student from a West Kootenay area secondary school
- Be enrolled or planning to enroll in a post-secondary trades or technical program in:
 - Carpentry/Joinery
 - Millwright
 - Fabrication
 - CNC/Manufacturing Technology
 - Architectural/Engineering Technology
 - Construction Management
 - Other manufacturing or skilled trades programs
- Demonstrate genuine interest in pursuing a career in manufacturing, fabrication, or skilled trades
- Show commitment to quality craftsmanship and continuous learning

Selection will prioritize candidates who demonstrate:

- **Hands-on experience** in building, making, or fabricating (whether through school projects, personal initiatives, or work experience)
- **Problem-solving mindset** and innovative thinking in their approach to challenges
- **Community contribution** through volunteer work, mentorship, or involvement in local projects

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must submit:

1. **Personal statement** (300-500 words) addressing:
 - Why you are pursuing a career in manufacturing or skilled trades
 - Describe a project or experience where you built, fabricated, or created something you're proud of
 - How you see yourself contributing to your community through your future career
 - Your goals for the first 5 years of your career
2. **Reference letter** from:
 - A teacher, instructor, employer, or community member who can speak to your work ethic and character
3. **Proof of enrollment or intention to enrol** in an accredited post-secondary trades or technical program

- Selection based on alignment with Spearhead's values and the candidate's demonstrated commitment to trades and manufacturing



- Preference given to applicants who demonstrate both technical aptitude and community mindedness
- Award recipient will be notified by **May 11, 2026**

AWARD PAYMENT

- Award recipient is decided by Spearhead Philanthropy Committee with final approval from ownership
- Award payment is administered by Spearhead Timberworks Inc
- Funds will be paid directly to the recipient upon proof of enrollment in an eligible program
- Funds must be used toward tuition, tools, equipment, or other education-related expenses
- Recipient must provide proof of enrollment by **September 18, 2026** to receive funds
