

# Required Courses for Grade 11 – English Program

All Grade 11 students must complete the following courses prior to graduation.


At least one English 11 Course

At least one Science 11 or 12 Course

At least one Social Studies 11 or 12 class – More on this later!

Electives and at least one indigenous-focused course


Students need 80 credits to graduate, but most choose to take more

All Grade 11 French Immersion students will be pre-enrolled in the following 2 French Immersion courses:

- Communication Orale 11
- Exploration en Sciences Humaines 11



# Requirements for Graduation

## Important notes about credits:


Of the 80 credits required to graduate, a minimum of 16 credits must be for courses at the Grade 12 level (generally 4 courses)

At least 4 credits must be from Indigenous-focused course work.

In addition to the 80 credits students must complete three Provincial Assessments:

- Literacy 10
- Numeracy 10
- Literacy 12



# LV ROGERS SCIENCE PATHWAYS




Students can explore science through different areas of study, including Life Sciences, Chemistry, Physics, and Earth Sciences. Each pathway develops scientific thinking while focusing on different questions about living systems, matter and reactions, motion and energy, or Earth's natural processes. Students are encouraged to choose courses that align with their interests, strengths, and future goals.

# Grade 11 Social Studies options

Students should take Exploration in Socials 11 to learn how Canada developed to this day and gain a better understanding of our national and international relationships. This is a foundational course to build students' skills in Social Studies.

Students can also take Law 12, BC First Peoples 12, Human Geography 12, or Comparative Cultures 12. These will go more in depth into the current social and political landscape. Students should expect a high degree of rigor as can be expected of Grade 12 coursework.





# Grade 11 English options

New for this year is Composition 11. Composition 11 provides opportunities for students to study, create, and write original and authentic pieces for a range of purposes and real-world audiences.

Students may also select Literary Studies 11, AP 11 Language and Composition.

Students can also still take Creative Writing 12 as an elective course to expand their writing repertoire. However, this course would be in addition to English 11, not in place of that coursework.

Students in Grade 11 can fill their schedules (after their required courses) with so many options.



# LVR Academies – applications required

- **LVR Dance**  
Includes an intensive academy course at LV Rogers Secondary integrates advanced technique classes in ballet and modern dance technique. Technique classes will be intensive and will focus on alignment, strength, flexibility, use of breath and musicality primarily through ballet and contemporary dance technique
- **ATLAS**  
Is an exciting career prep program for grade 12 students who have a strong personal interest in adventure recreation. This course will introduce students to the technical skills required for a variety of adventure-based industries. This opportunity will facilitate students to develop their “outdoor skills resume”, a requirement for many adventure tourism post-secondary programs.
- **Basketball**  
With a focus on practical and authentic experiences, students will hone their skills, coach and referee younger players and manage school tournaments. This course includes the teaching and practice of fundamental skills, offensive and defensive strategies, and positional play used at all levels of basketball.
- **Volleyball**  
The Volleyball Academy course provides a unique setting for students who are keen to improve their fundamental skills, learn offensive and defensive schemes and their overall understanding of the game of volleyball.





# Awards and Recognitions
